Sacred Motives I

Pastor Basinger (Auditorium)

Sometimes in the midst of our service, we lose sight of why we do what we do. We
slip into a pattern of empty routines or misguided ambition. In these sessions, you will
be challenged to take a thorough spiritual inventory – to allow the Holy Spirit of God
to explore the deepest motives of your soul and to reignite your passion to serve for

Chappell you will be challenged in your walk with God.
