CHURCH PICNIC

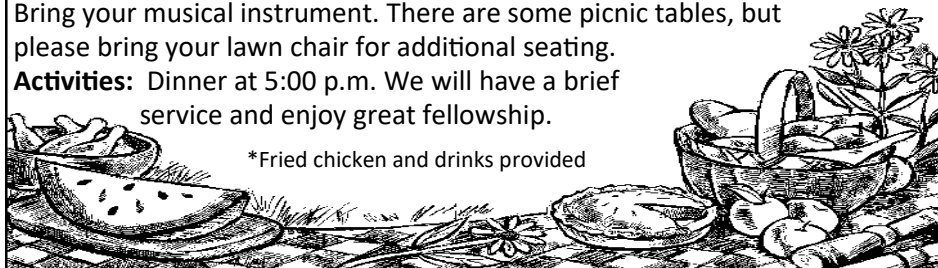
When: Sunday, May 25 at 4:30 p.m.
