- As Christ's servant, I have been set apart for a high purpose—proclaiming the gospel. *“separated unto the gospel of God”* See 2 Corinthians 5:19–20

For even the Son of man came not to be ministered unto, but to
minister, and to give his life a ransom for many.”*
