What is "Faith Promise Giving"?

FAITH PROMISE GIVING

- Agreeing with God that He loves the world and wants every person to have an opportunity to respond to the gospel of Christ
- Believing that God's resources are unlimited and He wants to provide the money needed for this global project through His church
- Prayerfully seeking for an amount which God lays upon your heart, committing yourself to give that amount to the Lord, and passing it on to the Lord's work trusting Him to provide your needs
- ♦ A voluntary commitment to God

What Does Faith Promise Giving Involve?

- 1. Submitting to the Lordship of Christ "...but first gave their own selves unto the Lord,..." 2 Cor. 8:5
- 2. Surrendering your will to His will "...they were willing of themselves;" 2 Cor. 8:3
- 3. Settling the issue voluntarily and privately between you and the Lord
 - "Every man according as he purposeth in his heart, so let him give; not grudgingly, or of necessity: for God loveth a cheerful giver.' 2 Cor. 9:7
- Satisfaction that God is able to provide "And God is able to make all grace abound toward you; that ye, always having all sufficiency in all things, may abound to every good work: "2 Cor. 9:8
- Sending the gospel to "the regions beyond" "...for we are come as far as to you also in preaching the gospel of Christ: ... having hope, when your faith is increased, that we shall be enlarged by you...To preach the gospel in the regions beyond vou..." 1 Cor. 10:14–16
