- Accountability for my choices (Acts 10:42; 2 Timothy 4:1; 1 Peter 4:5; 2 Corinthians 5:10; Revelation 20:11–15),
- His power to honor Him in my choices (Eph. 3:16; Romans 5:6–11; 6:6–14).

 God's grace to overcome any sinful distortion of His design. 1 Corinthians
 6:9–11
- Even if I want to change, there is no hope or no way out.
 <u>God's Truth</u>: God gives His children power and a way of escape in any temptation. 1 Corinthians 10:13
